

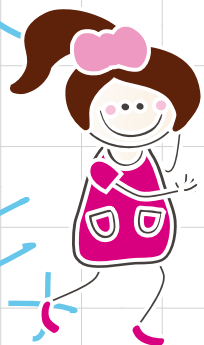

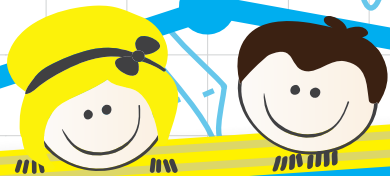
# ACHIEVER OF DISTINCTION IN CIE: PRAHESH KUMAR

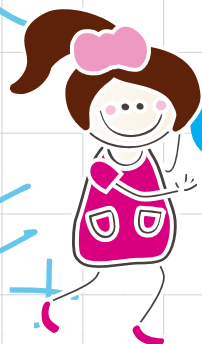

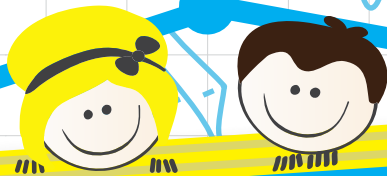

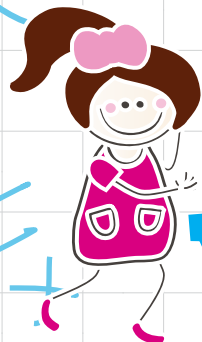
