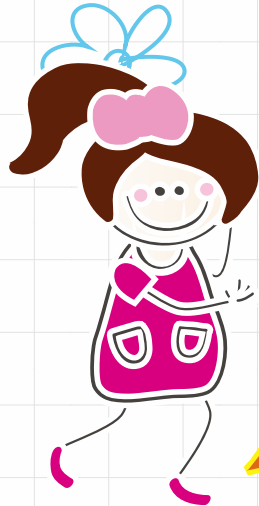


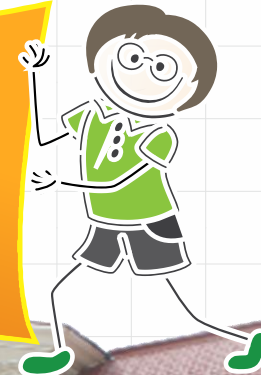

All the divergent stories narrated by kindergartners were well founded and applaudable.

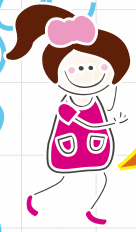


## 8<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL FUNCTION 2017-18
