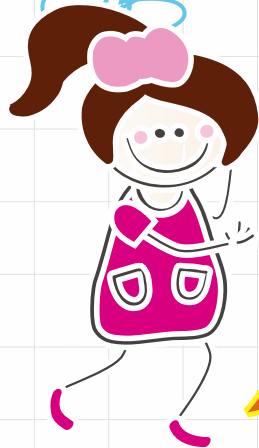

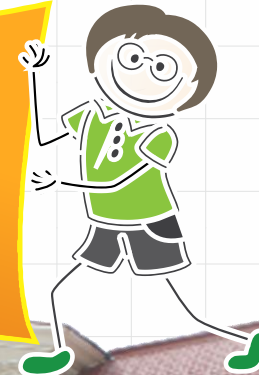

## Academic excellence award and the freshets' entertainment



Mrs. Jasbir Bassi Vice Chairperson CIS Phagwara City graced the occasion as the Chief Guest

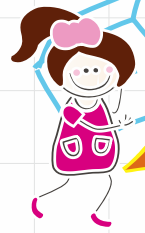
Students from class 1 to class 11 and CAIE received prizes for their excellence in academics for the year 2017-2018.

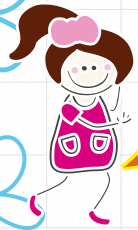
**Little efforts can do wonders.**

‘Leadership is the capacity to transform vision into reality.’


Cambridge International School, Phagwara organized its investiture ceremony on 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2018.
